When deciding where to form a Corporation or Limited Liability Company (LLC), business owners choose Texas thanks to a number of competitive factors including our best-in-class business climate, low tax burden—with no corporate or personal income tax—and predictable regulatory environment, among many other advantages. In fact, Texas has been named the Best State for Business in the U.S. for 20 years in a row by the nation's top executives.

Here in Texas, we have harnessed a pro-growth mindset by focusing on business success. Governor Greg Abbott is dedicated to ensuring our state moves at the speed of business by cutting red tape that hinders business formation and growth. That's why the number of business entities in the state has almost doubled in the last 10 years. It comes down to a key winning formula: we want businesses to succeed in Texas. Because when businesses succeed. all Texans succeed.

### FRIENDLY BUSINESS CLIMATE:

Texas has consistently been recognized for our superior business climate and pro-growth, pro-business attitude. Entrepreneurs have the foundation to thrive and freedom to aspire here in the Lone Star State. In fact, Texas was named the Best Business Climate in the nation in 2024 by Business Facilities and Site Selection magazines.

### **LOW TAX BURDEN:**

With no corporate or personal income tax, companies doing business in Texas enjoy one of the lowest overall tax burdens in the country.



### MOVING AT THE SPEED OF BUSINESS:

Texas is America's most dynamic economy because we move at the speed of business. In fact, our state continues to cut regulatory red tape that hinders business growth. Last year, Governor Abbott launched the Governor's Small Business Freedom Council to review government efficiency for Texas businesses. In March 2025, the Freedom Council released a comprehensive report with their recommendations to cut unnecessary government bureaucracy that create barriers to small business success in Texas. The report includes feedback from 46 Texas state agencies and nearly 700 Texas small businesses owners.

### **TEXAS SPECIALTY BUSINESS COURTS:**

Governor Abbott signed a law in 2023 creating the Texas Business Courts, a statewide, specialized trial court system created to resolve complex business disputes, presided over by judges with judicial or litigation experience in commercial matters. The Courts are composed of 11 geographical divisions consistent with the existing Administrative Judicial Regions. Five of those divisions are now operational in Dallas, Austin, San Antonio, Fort Worth and Houston.

- ★ Entrepreneurs in Texas have access to a large and collaborative startup network and burgeoning tech ecosystem. Thanks to a growing presence of accelerators and startup support infrastructure across the state, founders, innovators and venture capitalists have flocked to the Lone Star State.
- ★ Due to the state's immense size, Texas offers abundant and available space for businesses to grow, with relatively lower operating costs compared to other states.

- ★ Texas' central, strategic geographic location in the middle of North America offers logistical advantages, including easy access to domestic and international markets via land, sea and air.
- With a robust network of transportation infrastructure to support growing business needs, it's no surprise that Texas has led the nation in exports for the last 23 years in a row. In fact, Texas is home to more miles of public roadways, state highways, freight railways, airports and Foreign Trade Zones than any other state. Texas offers companies approximately 32 ports of entry, 23 seaports and 35 Foreign Trade Zones. The state's transportation network continues to get stronger as we continue to dedicate investment into our infrastructure, including a 10-year, \$148 billion commitment to new state transportation projects.
- Our greatest natural resource is the people of this great state, and they are the number one reason businesses locate here. We are home to a highly skilled, diverse and growing talent pool with worldclass schools that continue to cultivate the workforce of tomorrow. The Lone Star State is home to more than 15.5 million industrious Texans, the largest labor force in our state's history and among the youngest workforce in the nation. Texas has dominated the U.S. for population growth over the last two decades, attracting the best and brightest talent.
